In 1857, Queen Victoria chose Ottawa as the capital of Canada in edging out Quebec City, which then became the provincial capital of Quebec. Quebec is now one of Canada's largest cities. In 2016, a population of 531,902 was concentrated at 800,296 in the city centre, mostly French-speaking cities. Native English speakers represent only 1.5 percent of the city's population. In 2002, several nearby cities were annexed to support growth. Most of the city's economies are dependent on the transportation, tourism, services and defense sectors. Quebec City's main industrial products are pulp and paper, food, metal and wood, chemical and electronic items.
